15th Avenue Traffic Calming Improvements Between I & E Streets	1	Maintenance, Renovation and Repairs	500,000	The stretch of 15th Avenue between I and E Streets is a particularly active residential street connecting the East side of the South Addition Community to the West side. There are no intersections with stop signs or traffic lights between I & E Streets, traffic moves quickly through this stretch and pedestrians have a difficult time crossing safely. A traffic safety study will provide information necessary to determine how to improve this stretch of road. Estimated amount of funding this project includes traffic calming study costs and full-design engineering costs, in addition to improvements necessary to implement the recommended changes to improve safety. Complete Streets Study of A, C, I and L Streets, between Chester Creek Trail and Ninth Avenue	2	Planning and Research	750,000	This Study will identify capital improvements needed to: 1) Make the roadways compatible with adjacent homes and neighborhood character; 2) Continue to accommodate vehicle traffic; 3) Slow traffic speeds and noise; 4) Promote improved transit service; 5) Allow people to safely walk along and across the streets; 6) Encourage more people to walk and bicycle. E Street left-hand turning signal at 15th Avenue (north/south)	3	Maintenance, Renovation and Repairs	150,000	Replace the traffic signals at E Street and 15th Avenue to incorporate left-hand turn signals for the north and south lanes. Motorists often have to wait more than one cycle at the lights in order to make a left-hand turn, creating a safety hazard for pedestrians crossing at the end of the cycle. Underground Overhead Utility Lines in all South Addition Neighborhoods	4	Remodal and Reconstruction	3,000,000	Underground all overhead utility lines (telephone, cable, electric) in all South Addition neighborhood areas and remove related utility poles. Stair Repair/Replacement to the Chester Creek Trail at West 16th Avenue and I Street	5	Maintenance, Renovation and Repairs	250,000	Repair or replace the stairway as needed to enhance security and safety of those using the stairs to access either the Chester Creek Trail or to reach 16th Avenue at I Street, including changing the material used for the stairs and overhead cover similar to the improved Frank Read Sr Memorial Stairs at West 12th Avenue. The existing stairway is dark and the steps unsafe to travel; in addition, it is often used as temporary facilities for overnight camping. Delaney Park Hockey Rink Rehabilitation	6	Maintenance, Renovation and Repairs	450,000	Funding will be used to rehabilitate the rink. The hockey rink at Delaney Park is a well-used winter facility. Upgrades are needed in the future to ensure that this popular sports facility can continue to serve park users. Delaney Park	7	Maintenance, Renovation and Repairs	1,600,000	Funding will make repairs to turf, walking areas, landscape, amenities and athletic facilities, and renovate subgrade and surfacing of tennis courts. Funds are needed to maintain Delaney Park as a vibrant public space serving all of Anchorage. The constant wear and tear of major events and sports use, combined with outdated facilities, has caused major park infrastructure decline. Earl & Muriel King Park	8	Remodal and Reconstruction	200,000	Funding will be used to both identify and construct improvements in this neighborhood park. Earl & Muriel King Park is an underutilized neighborhood park bordering the Downtown/Fairview/South Addition neighborhoods. In the recent past, park neighbors and residents have expressed frustration with negative uses occurring in the park. Funds will be used to identify and construct park improvements.
